Head to Encinitas, the surf and yoga sanctuary situated along the historical Highway 101 in North San Diego, and hunt down the perfect fish taco. You'll find your center, and it'll be full.

One of the many perks of living in Southern California is the beach, and what pairs better with beach-life than tacos and beer? It's only natural that tacos have become a part of our weekly diet with Mexico right next door to us. In fact, we locals love tacos so much we even dedicated a whole day of the week to them with Taco Tuesday! And we found a few taquerias for next Tuesday that you can dive into some amazing fish tacos.

Jorge's Mexicatessen

The fish here is deep-fried but somehow manages to keep the fresh ocean flavor that other shops generally loose in the batter. This hidden gem doesn't even have a website and boasts a simple, family feel. You'll find the food at Jorge's Mexicatessen a cut above your average taco shop as everything is made with strong, home-style recipes and flavor. Plus they take credit cards, so no need to arm yourself with cash.

With a bit of Baja in every bite, you can't go wrong with a couple of aptly named Cousteau tacos. These yumtastic tacos feature non-GMO corn tortillas, sautéed and seasoned fresh local catch, cabbage slaw, cumin-lime crema with a mango salsa cruda cilantro. Jasmine rice and red beans offered on the side perfectly round out this organic dish. With a proud ownership committed to quality, this local favorite is located just a few blocks from downtown Encinitas North on the 101 in Leucadia.

With a dog-friendly patio and an awarding-winning taco called the TKO Taco, Encinitas newest, local business is serving up their freshest catches. Tacos here are a choose-your-own-adventure experience broken out into simple steps. Start by choosing your fish, anything from mahi-mahi and ahi to local halibut and albacore. Next, pick your seasoning or a marinade like teriyaki of chipotle glaze. Finally, select taco-style and throw sides of fries, onion rings or salad into the mix for a plate that'll make your taste buds sing of the sea.

But once they sell out, they're out. Also, make sure you grab a side of the notable homemade salsa.
